B – INDEX STRUCTURE

- References given in the entries in this index consist of the *CP TRACKS* issue designation in **bold** characters as given on page 1 or 2 of these introductory notes followed by the issue's page(s) or page range in **bold** characters. If a reference's page or range of pages has a specific content, it bears one or more of the superscripts given and described at the bottom of each page of the index.
- Entries are given in letter-by-letter order, that is with word spaces and all punctuation marks ignored and acronyms and numbers treated as if they were spelled out. Exceptions are made occasionally to avoid separating closely related entries.
- Italics in the index are used for the titles of books, periodicals, video tapes, and DVDs; they are also used for the names of named trains, locomotives, passengers, business and private cars, ships, and airplanes.
- Dates in the index are given in the Month/Day/Year format.
- Articles' titles and entries are given under their author(s) name(s).
- The fastest way to find all the entries on a specific CP/CPKC locomotive is to look it up in its type's listing by road number. Two such listings are provided: DIESEL LOCOMOTIVES, CPKC's System's, and STEAM LOCOMOTIVES, CP's System.
- The fastest way to find all the entries on a specific locomotive of a CP/CPKC subsidiary company or a non-CP/CPKC company, is to look it up in that company's index entry.
- If a locomotive road number in the listings mentioned above is followed by "preserved", the information on that locomotive will be found under the index entry of the location referred to.
- When the road number of a specific locomotive is given a suffix such as :1, :2, and so on, the suffix indicates the number of times that particular road number has been used; this is mostly done to accurately distinguish the locomotive from other locomotives bearing the same RN in the listings.
- In some cases, a specific locomotive's various road numbers in the same, or other companies, are given in descending chronological order or, if the locomotive is being preserved, in the index entry of the location referred to; this is most often done to properly identify the road number and livery the locomotive bears on its photographs referred to in the index.
- Road numbers of rolling stock items are entered in their respective type's listings as for locomotives. If the item is being preserved, the information on it will be found under the index entry of the location referred to.
- Road number changes for rolling stock items follow the procedure used for locomotives.
